The Board will conduct this meeting remotely pursuant to An Act Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency signed into law by Governor Charles Baker on June 16, 2021. The Act extended until April 1, 2022, the remote meeting provisions of Governor Baker's March 12, 2020, Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law. The Act authorized public bodies to continue providing live "adequate, alternative means" of public access to the deliberations of the public body, instead of holding meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public and further allows all members of a public body to continue participating in meetings remotely.
