Parks Recreation & Beaches Department Releases 2017 Application to Waive Greens Fees for the Whaling City Golf Course

New Bedford, Massachusetts—The City of New Bedford Parks Recreation & Beaches has released the 2017 Application to Waive the Green Fees for the Whaling City Golf Course for the coming season. Non-profit organizations interested in holding a golf tournament at the Whaling City Golf Course may apply for a waiver of the Greens Fees by submitting a completed application by March 3, 2017. Applications will be reviewed at the March 15, 2017 Park Board of Commissioners monthly meeting. Organizations are encouraged to apply with the stipulation that tournaments held on weekdays (if selected) will not require any food obligations to the Whaling City Golf Course. Weekend tournaments (if selected) will require a food concession agreement.

In addition to completing the application, all applicants will be required to describe the organization's mission, their impact on the community and how the profits from the tournament will be used.
