Our equipment is available to New Bedford residents and organizations working on their tv shows to air on Channel 95.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

New Bedford residents and non-profit oganizations are eligible to have their programs run on Channel 95.

In order to use our facilities and equipment, residents and organizations must first complete our training course.
