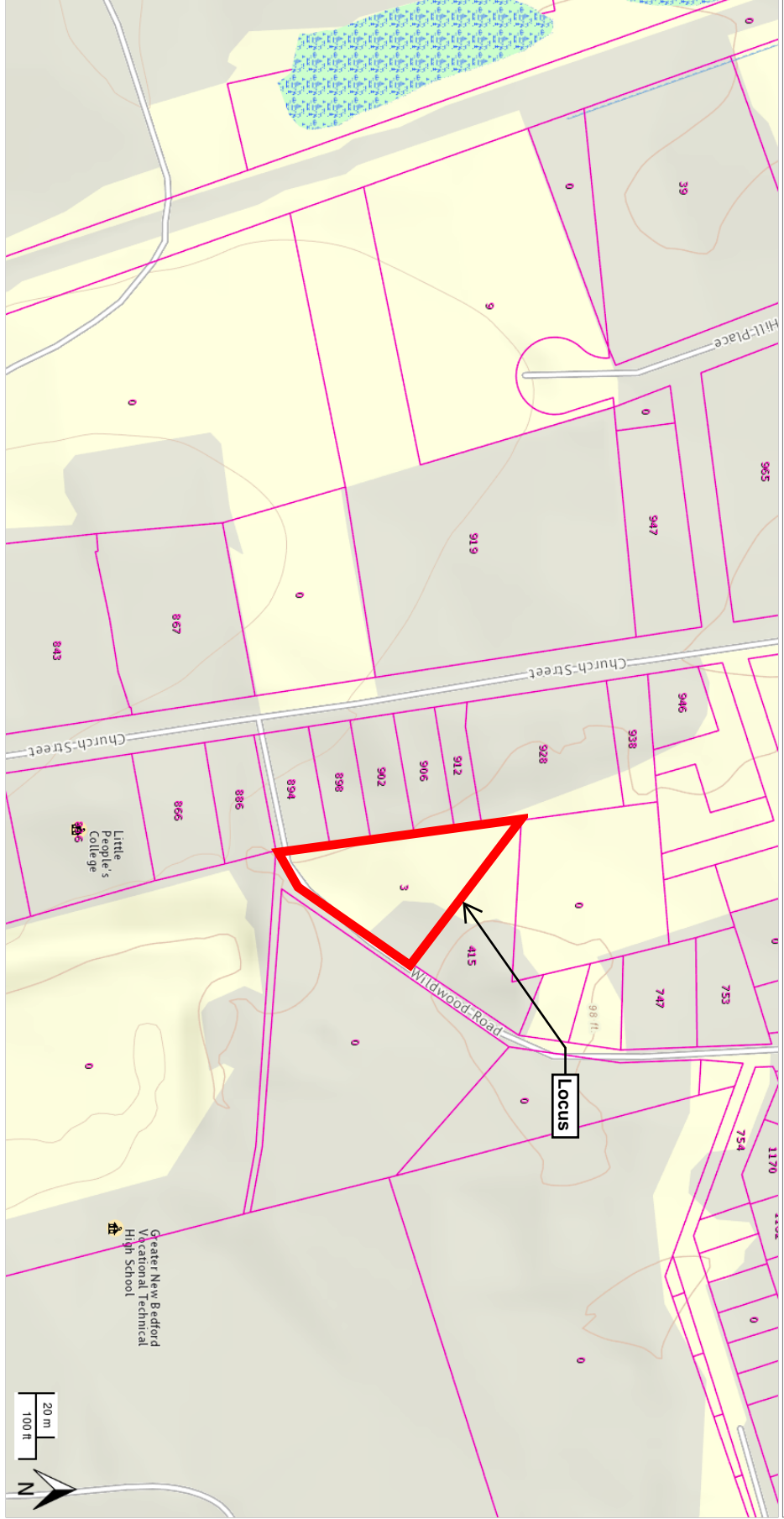
Figure 4 - Outstanding Resource Waters & FEMA Flood Data

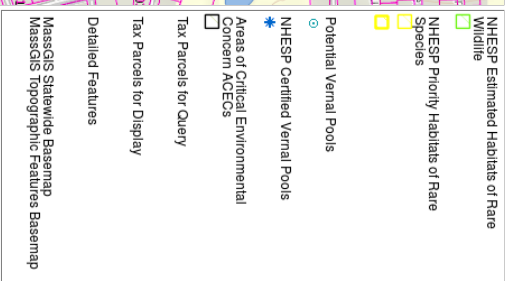
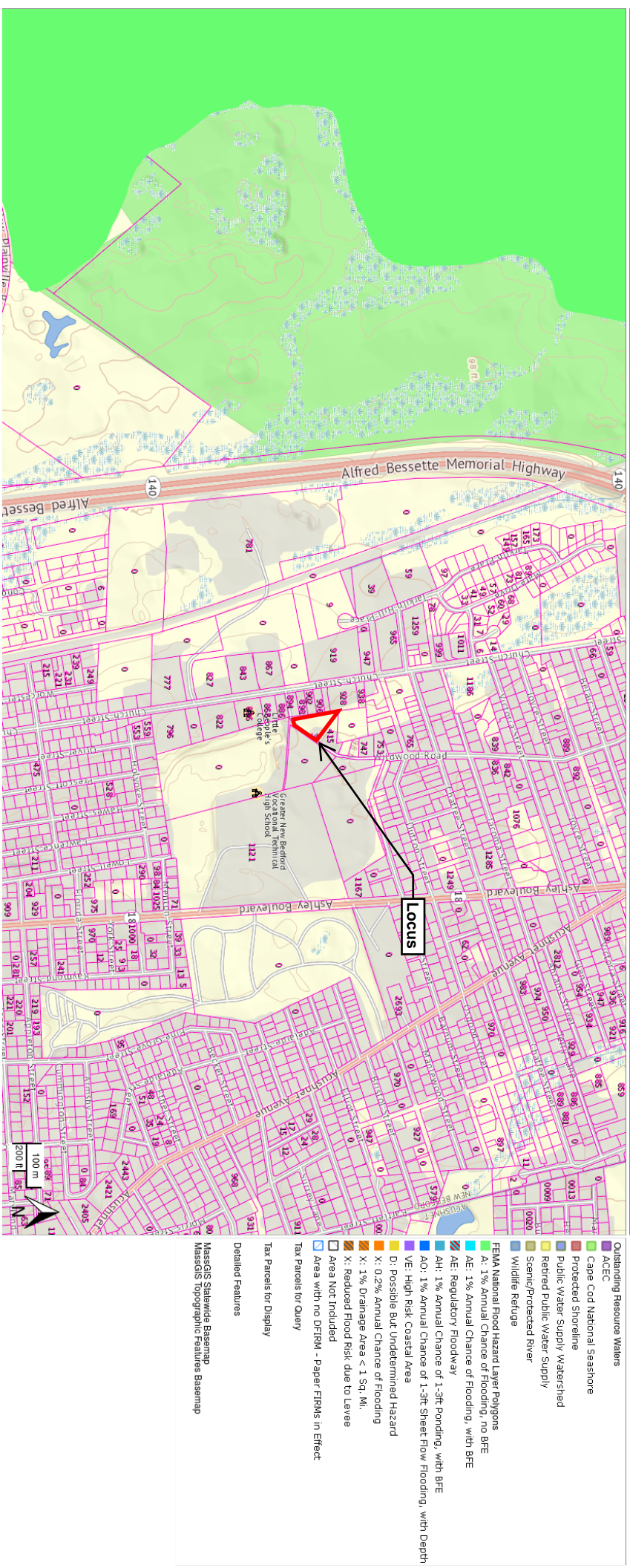
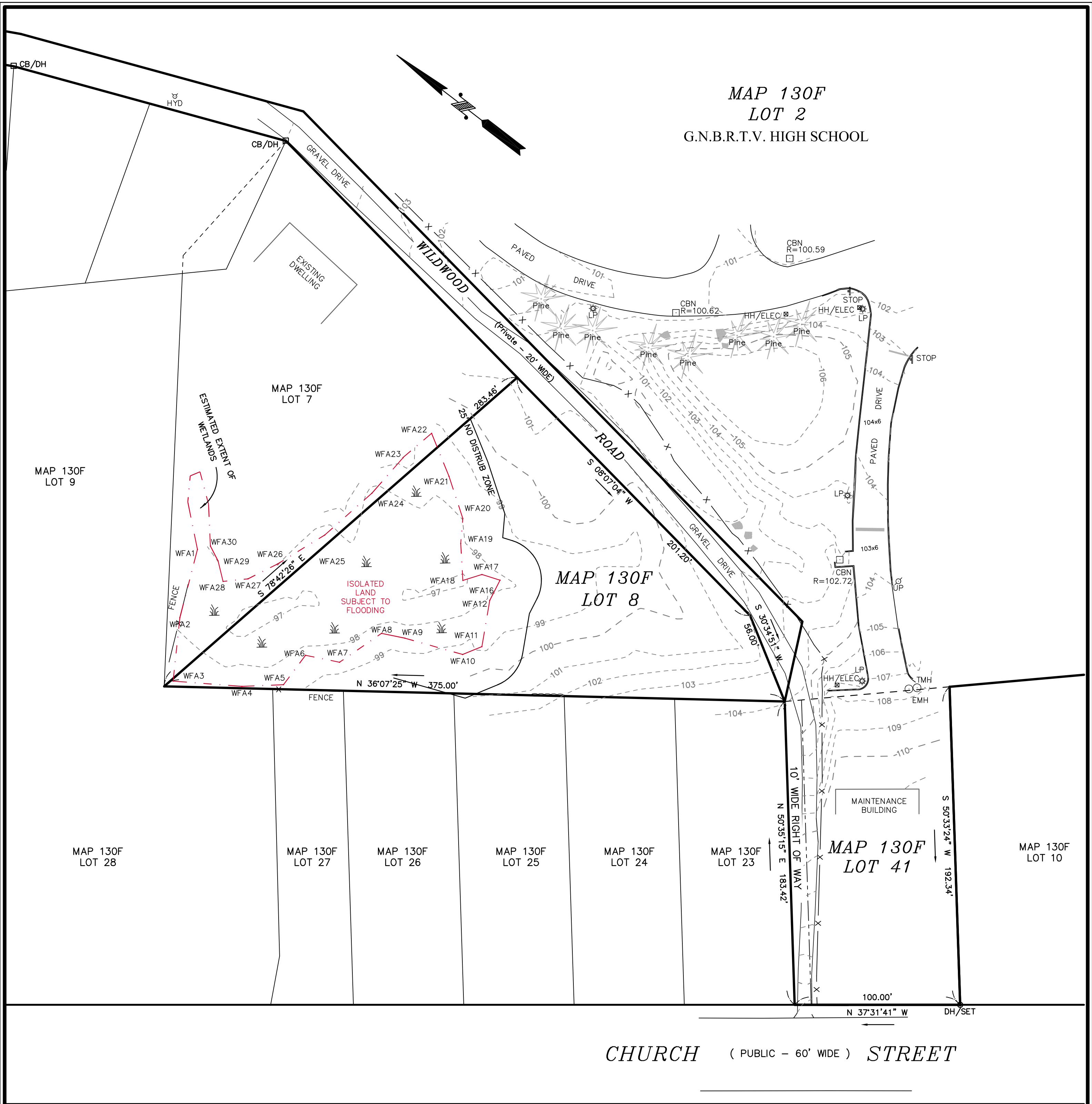


Figure 4 - FEMA Special Flood Hazard Areas & ORWs - New Bedford Vocational Technical High School

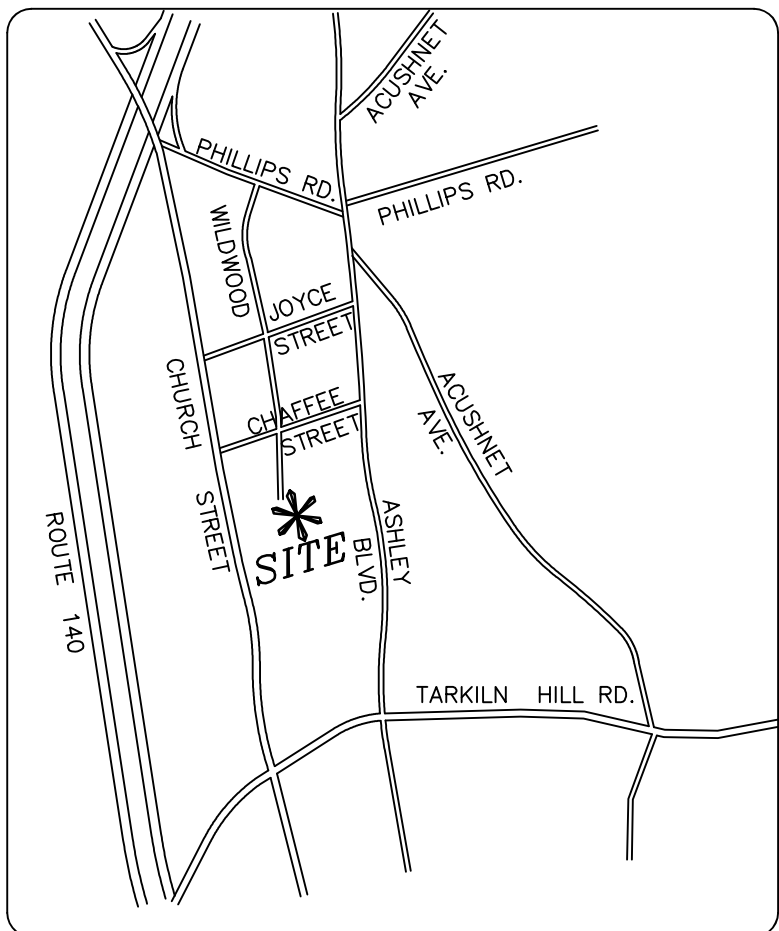

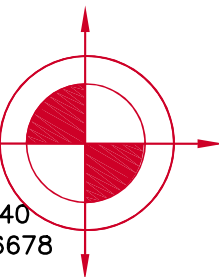

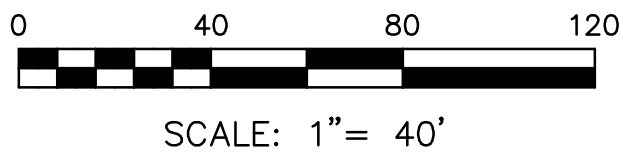
