2. Extent and Type of Activity (if more space is required, please attach a separate sheet):

In response to a complaint received by MA DEP, the New Bedford Conservation Agent inspected 352 Herman Melville Boulevard on 9/18/19. The inspection revealed that fill material has been placed on approximately 200 linear feet of Coastal Bank (310 CMR 10.30). The fill material has also entered Land Under the Ocean (310 CMR 10.25) a.k.a. the Acushnet River in a Designated Port Area (310 CMR 10.26). The Coastal Bank is now destabilized because the fill material is loose and creating an erodible embankment which could cause additional fill to enter the Acushnet River. Additionally, two prefabricated buildings are within the 100' Buffer Zone. They are not on the ground but if they are to be placed on site permanently, a Notice of Intent will need to be filed before they are placed on the ground. All of the above activities are also located within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage (310 CMR 10.21).

B. Findings



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The Issuing Authority has determined that the activity described above is in a resource area and/or buffer zone and is in violation of the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, § 40) and its Regulations (310
