1. Review and consider two Open Meeting Law complaints filed with the Conservation Commission.

Chairman Dixon stated that there have been two complaints filed, one by Louis Macedo of 14 Nina Street, New Bedford, MA and one by Dorvalino De Medeiros of 1242 East Rodney French Boulevard, New Bedford, MA. Both complaints are identical and state that a determination was made on the waterpark project without holding a public hearing, and Chairman made a unilateral decision, that shocked the Board. He was quoted that he was pressured by the Mayor. City is partnered with Altitude H20 Waterpark and allowed park to open. This was learned by an article in the Standard Times on 7/19/19 written by Kiernan Dunlop. They would like to invalidate the actions taken and impose fines and penalties as appropriate.

Chairman Dixon advised this Commission has 14 days to review the complaints and allegations and take remedial action as appropriate and can either provide a response on their own or to move to allow the Solicitor's Office to file a response to the Complainants and the Attorney General.
