	No further work shall be performed until a public hearing has been held and an Order of Conditions has been issued to regulate said work.  The property owner shall take the following action (e.g., erosion/sedimentation controls) to
	prevent further violations of the Act:  Before August 3, 2019, the property owner shall install a split rail fence (or equivalent as approved by the Conservation Agent) 25' away (west) from the boundary of the BVW. A sign shall be placed on the fence stating that a protected Conservation Area exists beyond this fence and is to remain undisturbed per order of the New Bedford Conservation Commission. This sign shall be placed on the fence before August 3, 2019.
	Failure to comply with this Order may constitute grounds for additional legal action. Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 provides: "Whoever violates any provision of this section (a) shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or both, such fine and imprisonment; or (b) shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for each violation". Each day or portion thereof of continuing violation shall constitute a separate offense.
