No further work shall be performed until a public hearing has been held and an Order of Conditions has been issued to regulate said work. The property owner shall take the following action (e.g., erosion/sedimentation controls) to
prevent further violations of the Act: The property owner shall appear at the next Conservation Commission meeting on Tuesday May 7, 2019 at 6:30 PM at the Brooklawn Senior Center, 1997 Acushnet Avenue, New Bedford to obtain approval of the restoration plan and any other requirements by the Conservation Commission. No further work is permitted until you have an approved restoration plan, schedule and any additional orders from the Conservation Commission (if required).
Failure to comply with this Order may constitute grounds for additional legal action. Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 provides: "Whoever violates any provision of this section (a) shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or both, such fine and imprisonment; or (b) shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for each violation". Each day or portion thereof of continuing violation shall constitute a separate offense.
D. Appeals/Signatures
An Enforcement Order issued by a Conservation Commission cannot be appealed to the Department of Environmental Protection, but may be filed in Superior Court.
