Current vegetation consists of invasive species which create a barrier to vision lines to the dock and the river. The vegetation also creates a nuisance area with the occasional "camper" taking refuge overnight in the vegetation.

To maintain the Coastal Bank, we will remove invasive plant material and create vistas of the river by mechanical removal of the bittersweet, multi flora rose, and other invasive plant material and replace with native perennials. The plant material will be cut to the ground and the remaining stems will be treated with Rodeo. Material will be removed



from the site and composted. We will prevent any erosion down the coastal bank by immediately placing natural wood chips over the bare ground and tamping down to prevent soil movement

Native perennial plant material will be selected from the Massachusetts Office of Coastal Zone Management Coastal Landscaping in Massachusetts - Plant List found at https://www.mass.gov/service-details/coastal-landscaping-in-massachusetts-plant-list#coastal-bank-plant-list.


