The Orders for this project were issued on January 21, 2002 to former owner American Seafoods International LLC (ASI), at which time a portion of the work was completed to extend the parking area on the south side of the facility. No further work was done at that time, the orders expired, and the property was sold to APS, LLC in October 2013, and subsequently sold to Blue Harvest in September 2016.

Since the orders had expired before work was completed, Blue Harvest submitted an RDA in July 2017 to permit the installation of a sediment trap and a bituminous berm in the south parking area to provide improvements to stormwater collection and treatment. With this work recently completed, Blue Harvest now requests a certificate of compliance for the work performed under DEP File #SE49-311. This work includes additional paved parking and stormwater improvements for the south parking area. Similar work that had been proposed and permitted for additional parking and stormwater improvements for the north parking area was not performed.

Attached are copies of the maintenance agreement for the quarterly cleaning and inspection of catch basins and sediment trap, and a copy of the latest invoice for these services.

It is my professional opinion that the work that was performed for this project has been satisfactorily completed and that a certificate of compliance should be issued for the project.


