1. & 2. Prior to your October 1 memo, we realized that the northern edge of the BVW had not been delineated in the field or shown on the plan. The Wetland Scientist has been directed to flag the northern limit of the BVW, which we expect to occur this week. Once that has been completed and shown on the plan, we will arrange for the Wetland Scientist to review the delineation in the field with you. It is clear to us that the replication area will need to be re-designed so no portion of it falls within the BVW. The revised plan will be forthcoming.
3. Flags 3 & 4 will be re-set in the field, then surveyed and a revised plan will be submitted to you.
