
Dear Commission Members:

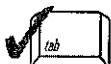
