Re: 61 John Vertente Boulevard - Notice of Intent 54
Wetland Flagging Notes

- 1. It is only necessary to flag from flag 212 easterly to John Vertente Boulevard.
- 2. It is only necessary to flag from flag 152 easterly to John Vertente Boulevard.
- 3. Be sure and determine the size of the culvert under the entrance to the site and mark the approximate width of the channel on either side of the entrance for a distance of 20' to 30' north and south of the entranceway.
- 4. Flag 227 is missing this flag should be replaced as t is likely that it is approximately 5° south of flag 225.
- 5. From looking westerly through the fence, and examining the intermittent stream where the fence ends it appears that the BVW bordering this small channel may continue easterly past the fence. A detention pond discharges into this channel approximately 35' west of the fence and may contribute to the wetland hydrology. Please have EcoSystem Solutions look to see if wetland flags should be added here.
- 6. In the utility easement, flags east of 242 were missing in the field and flags east of 317 were missing. I would like to see flag 243 replaced and flags 314 through 316 replaced because they are near the construction area for the wetland replication.
- 7. Wetland flag 126 was found in the field and that was the last one found along the northern portion of the property. These flags are also not shown on the plans. It is only necessary to relocate flags to the northern property boundary. It is not necessary to relocate the flags along Barnet Boulevard.
