### March/ April

 Remove shells accumulated from winter wave activity from beach between Mean High Water (MHW) mark and beginning of coastal bank vegetation line.

### May 1st - July 30th

- No mechanical work, maintenance, disturbance, etc. for 'wildlife protection season' most notably Horseshoe Crab (*Limulus polyphemus*) that lays eggs and hatch near the High Water Mark, under Full and New moon spring tide conditions.
- General trash removal permitted

#### August 1st - October 31st


