NEW BUSINESS:

 <u>SE049-0848</u> – A requests to extend an Order of Conditions issued March 26, 2019 as filed by Chris Newhall of Eversource Energy (Map 134, Lot 17+318). The applicant intends to conduct subsurface geotechnical investigation (borings) within the utility right of way between Philips Road and Dartmouth town line.

Karen Hanecak was present tonight instead of Chris Hall, representing Eversource Energy. Eversource is requesting an extension to the *Order of Conditions* issued on March 22, 2019 for proposed subsurface geotechnical investigations in the City of New Bedford. The Project involves the

completion of geotechnical borings to support the engineering design and pre-construction planning for proposed improvements related to transmission system upgrades for the Acushnet to Fall River Reliability Project. A total of five soil borings will be completed, two borings are located in Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW), one boring is located in the 100-foot-wide wetland buffer zone; and the remaining two are located in upland. The boring locations, proposed access, and wetland impact analysis remain the same as submitted and approved in 2019 keeping this classified as minor activity. The Project planning and engineering design phase has been delayed, and the Order of Conditions is now approaching expiration on March 22, 2022. However, Eversource is now at a point where the subsurface geotechnical investigations need to be conducted to allow for completion of the engineering design phase. Eversource anticipates completion of the geotechnical borings before the end of this year.

Agent Perks reminded about the Special Condition #51 regarding a pre-con meeting on the site that will need to be set up with the agent. Agent Perks asked if they will be filing a separate *Notice of Intent* for the pole installations, which Ms. Hanecak replied that they will be filing one soon.

Commissioner Carney made a motion to Extend the Order of Conditions with Special Conditions #51 as read by the Agent.

The applicant intends to construct a single-family home with associated grading and utilities within an existing resource area and buffer zone, which includes wetland replication of the disturbed wetland resource area. Representative is Alison Cesar of Sitec, Inc.



Mr. Steve Gioiosa was present in place of Alison Cesar representing Jose Castelo. Mr. Gioiosa stated that they made the changes the Commissioners recommended from the last meeting. The plans showed how they shrunk the amount of impacted area from 300,000 Sq ft to 230,000 Sq ft by running the utilities under the driveway and moving the replication area closer to the driveway. By doing this, all work is being compressed to the front portion of the site and eliminating the activity in the back portion.

Agent Perks asked about utilities and pole layout. Mr. Gioiosa stated that once this is approved, they would send the plans to Eversource which in return would let them know how many poles and where poles would be placed. Agent Perks also question about the trees being planted. He suggested keeping the same size trees but reducing the tree number from 8 & 8 to 4 & 4. Agent Perks recommends issuing an *Notice of Intent* that includes the *Standard Inland Resource Area Special Conditions* and 2 Special Conditions that states Agent Perks be notified in writing when Eversource gives location of utility poles and the reduction of number of trees planted from 8 & 8 to 4 & 4.
