#### **QUITCLAIM DEED**

We, ANTONIO NOGUEIRA and MANUELA L. DACOSTA, married, of 450 West Rodney French Blvd., New Bedford, MA in consideration of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND and 00/100 (\$230,0000.00 Dollars), paid, grant to RYAN E. HARRINGTON and LARA L. HARRINGTON, as Tenants by the Entirety, of 450 West Rodney French Blvd., New Bedford, MA, with quitclaim covenants

The land with the buildings thereon situated in New Bedford, Bristol County, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, known and numbered as 450 West Rodney French Boulevard, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point forty-four feet south of the intersection of the easterly line of West French Avenue and the southerly line of Bellevue Street;
