Dear Board Members,

On behalf of my clients, the owners of the subject parcel, I am submitting the enclosed Variance Request Package with regards to the above referenced property. The submittal package includes the following:

The subject Parcel is located within a Residence B District which requires a minimum of 75' of frontage and 8,000 sq.ft. of area for a single family dwelling and 10,000 sq.ft. for a two family dwelling.

The owners of the subject parcel are seeking relief from the Zoning Board of Appeals allowing the construction of a new single family dwelling on a parcel of land with 80' of frontage along Holden Street and containing 5,495 sq.ft.in area.

As discussed in a previous petition, as described in the attached deed, this parcel is comprised of two smaller parcels on land. The City of New Bedford Assessor's office lists the vacant parcel as Map 118 Lot 223 with 80' of frontage along Holden Street and containing 5,495 sq.ft.in area. The applicants as well as the previous owners of the parcel have consistently been assessed and taxed as owning a separate parcel with land values of \$86,100.

Having purchased the property in 2013, and seeing that the parcel was being taxed separately to the fullest value, the owners assumed that they would be able to construct a new dwelling on the vacant parcel. After submitting a site plan to the Zoning Enforcement Officer seeking a finding in accordance with Chapter 9, Section 2612.a,b,c&d (Merger of Lots)the owners were denied permission to build. As illustrated through the enclosed denials, the Zoning Enforcement officer has made the determination that this parcel has been combined with an abutting parcel, he has asked that we submit two separate petitions to achieve our goals. We have filed a parallel petition requesting permission to subdivide the over all parcel.

The proposed construction activities require that we seek relief with regards to Section 2710, 2711, 2720 & 2750 of the Zoning Bylaw. The applicant is proposing the construction of a single family dwelling on a parcel of land with 5,495 sq.ft. in lieu of the required 8,000 sq.ft. for the district. Additionally, we would be proposing a rear yard setback of 20' to the dwelling in lieu of the required 30' setback and lastly a rear yard setback of 11' to the proposed deck in lieu of the required 30'

For the following reasons and parcel history we request that the Board act favorably upon our request:

- 1. The existing parcel configuration/shape mimics the original parcel prior to merger. When applying to construct the single family dwelling we made every attempt to meet the required building setbacks. The required front yard setback for this parcel would be 2.9' (average of abutting properties). However, the Zoning Enforcement Officer requested that we push the proposed dwelling back to the 20' setback to insure that no vehicles would be parked within the Right of Way. We are attempting to accommodate this request through the filing of this petition.
- 2. The applicants as well as the previous owners of the parcel have consistently been assessed and taxed as owning the separate parcel with a land value \$86,100.
- 3. The parcel and proposed dwelling size and setbacks are comparable in size and shape to many of the lots within the immediate area.
- 4. The granting of relief would not derogate from the intent of the ordinance which is intended to create reasonably sized lots with adequate building separation.

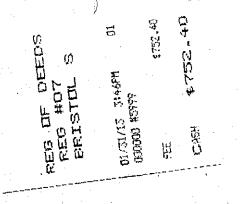
5. The construction of a new single family dwelling in the neighborhood would be an aesthetic improvement as well as to create increased tax base and property values.

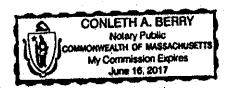
