The project is located on the property of the Boys & Girls Club of Greater New Bedford located at 166 Jenney Street New Bedford.

The scope of work is to expand on the existing playground structure which was erected last year which will expand on the usage of the current playground, as well as upgrade existing basketball court.

Thanks to the ability and opportunity to install a new playground solidfied the need for the playground within the community. The Boys & Girls Club mission is to focus on the underserved youth within the community. The project will serve over 1,000 youth annually with more than 60% of those served from low to moderate income households.

The project will allow the Boys & Girls Club to expand its outdoor playground area that will serve more youth and expand opportunity for outdoor recreational activity. The Boys & Girls Club is within walking distance of over 500 public housing units.

We are looking to expand upon the present playground as well as renovate and update existing basketball court while adding benches and bleacher to the property.

The Installation of a ourdoor concrete platform will enhance the sites ability to have multiple use as this would provide for a summer and fall ourdoor class space as well as a area for summer program lunches and breakfast.
Failure to acquire CPA funding would adversely affect playground expansion and seating area as well as basketball court renovations. This funding would allow for project to move forward and will assist the Boys & Girls Club in strengthening its chance for private foundation funding success.
