- 3. The Park Board will vote to approve the decrease in park use fee discount as follows:
 - a. Resident will have a 75% discount instead of 80%
 - b. For Profit and Non -Residents will receive no discount
 - c. Not For Profit discount at Park Board discretion up to 75% discount
- 4. Park Board votes to take the lead with NBFD Fire Prevention Office and Community Members to develop a policy regarding the use of grills in the parks. The Policy will be in place for Spring 2019.
- 5. Park Board to begin conversation regarding limits on the size of events at the parks to create guidelines for summer 2019.
- 6. Swan Boats operators, Alan and Cynthia Days of La Gondola, request forgiveness of \$2,500.00 remaining on their \$5,000.00 seasonal fee to operate at Buttonwood Pond. They have made a significant investment in the
